- 8. I had been waiting / 'd been waiting (wait) two years until I had money to buy a new car.
- 9. The baby <u>had been eating / 'd been eating</u> (eat) chocolate. For that reason, his face was so dirty.

10. She <u>had been playing</u> (play) the piano for two hours when the neighbours finally knocked her door to ask her to

stop. It was very late and they wanted to sleep.
