Grammar explanation: English, Spanish

Turn the following sentences into negative and interrogative using present perfect simple:

1. The plumber <u>has fixed / 's fixed</u> (fix) the water tap.

Negative: The plumber hasn't fixed the water tap / the plumber has not fixed the water tap / The plumber has not fixed the water tap / the plumber has not fixed the water tap .

Question: Has the plumber fixed the water tap / has the plumber fixed the water tap ?

2. The carpenter <u>has made / 's made</u> (make) a nice table.

Negative: The carpenter hasn't made a nice table / the carpenter hasn't made a nice table / The carpenter has not made a nice table / the carpenter has not made a nice table .

Question: Has the carpenter made a nice table / has the carpenter made a nice table ?

3. She <u>has already arrived / 's already arrived</u> (already / arrive). ()

Negative: She hasn't arrived yet / She has not arrived yet / She's not arrived yet . ()

Question: <u>Has she arrived yet / Has she arrived yet ?</u> ()
